Airport Arrivals and Departures (Adult Volunteers/Cadets)

Any cadets or escort officers who may be flying into North Florida need to confirm flights and arrange transportation between the training site and Jacksonville International Airport with the COTC no later than 15 days prior to the training date. Transportation will be provided for pickup/departure at the Jacksonville Airport. **All arrivals on 27DEC22 and 28DEC22**, must be scheduled to arrive between 1000-1200hrs. All cadets arriving will meet in front of the USO office, located within the airport.

All departures need to be scheduled for your cadet to fly out on **1JAN22 & 3JAN22** between 1500-1700hrs.

Check-In/Graduation Times

DROP OFF and PICK OFF at Camp Blanding will be conducted outside the gate in our predetermined authorized area. Camp Blanding is an active Military Installation, only authorized access onto the base is authorized.

Check in for Staff Cadets will be **27DEC22 at 0800-0900hrs**. Cadets attending Recruit Training check in will begin at 0900-1000hrs, on 27DEC22. POLA/CPOA/NLCC Basic Orientation will check in on 28DEC22 from 0900-1000hrs.

Graduation will be on **1JAN22 at 1100hrs for (NLO, POLA, CPOA)**. Recruit Training Graduation will be at **3JAN22 1100hrs**.

Detailed Registration Instructions:

- **Parent Portal** all prerequisites must be completed prior to issuance of any training order approvals. This is the parents' responsibility along with the Unit Commanding Officers'/designee to ensure these are completed, in accordance with regulations.
- Training Guidance Policy will be followed regarding Medical Exams, History, Supplemental, and Accommodations.
- No Service Jackets are not required since implementation of the parent portal all information can be accessed within Magellan. However, the cadet will need to bring a copy of their signed orders and ID Card.
- CO TOP6, COVID Waiver, must be signed/uploaded within the documents section of Magellan.
- Staff Cadets can request their billet assignments via the following google form link. Billet assignments will be determined by the Staff Cadets experience, record book, and approval from the OIC of that training. <https://forms.gle/Sr3rPzgDG2oShnmN9>

Cadets must have postage and know how to properly address a letter home so that it will arrive properly.
